# 1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE SUBSTANCE / PREPARATION AND OF THE COMPANY / UNDERTAKING

Use / description of product: Aerosol. Extremely flammable. Irritant.

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#### 2. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

**Hazardous ingredients:** 

•PROPAN-2-OL 30-50% EINECS: 200-661-7 CAS: 67-63-0 [F] R11; [Xi] R36; [-]R67

• ACETONE 10-30% EINECS: 200-662-2 CAS: 67-64-1[F] R11; [Xi] R36; [-] R66; [-] R67

• BUTANE 10-30% EINECS: 203-448-7 CAS: 106-97-8[F+] R12

#### 3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

**Main hazards:** Extremely flammable. Irritating to eyes. Vapours may cause drowsiness and dizziness

Other hazards: In use, may form flammable / explosive vapour-air mixture.

# **4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)**

**Skin contact:** There may be irritation and redness at the site of contact.

**Eye contact:** There may be irritation and redness. The eyes may water profusely.

**Ingestion:** There may be soreness and redness of the mouth and throat.

**Inhalation:** There may be irritation of the throat with a feeling of tightness in the chest. Exposure may cause coughing or wheezing.

## 4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

**Skin contact:** Remove all contaminated clothes and footwear immediately unless stuck to skin. Drench the affected skin with running water for 10 minutes or longer if substance is still on skin. Transfer to hospital if there are burns or symptoms of poisoning.

**Eye contact:** Bathe the eye with running water for 15 minutes. Transfer to hospital for specialist examination.

**Ingestion:** Do not induce vomiting. If conscious, give 1 pint of water to drink immediately. If unconscious, check for breathing and apply artificial respiration if necessary. If unconscious and breathing is OK, place in the recovery position. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

**Inhalation:** Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so. If unconscious, check for breathing and apply artificial respiration if necessary. If unconscious and breathing is OK, place in the recovery position. If conscious, ensure the casualty sits or lies down. If breathing becomes bubbly, have the casualty sit and provide oxygen if available. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

#### 5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing media: Carbon dioxide.

**Exposure hazards:** Extremely flammable. In combustion emits toxic fumes. Vapour may travel considerable distance to source of ignition and flash back. Forms explosive air-vapour mixture.

**Protection of fire-fighters:** Wear self-contained breathing apparatus. Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.

## 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

**Personal precautions:** Eliminate all sources of ignition. Mark out the contaminated area with signs and prevent access to unauthorised personnel. Turn leaking containers leak-side up to prevent the escape of liquid.

**Environmental precautions:** Do not discharge into drains or rivers. Contain the spillage using bunding.

**Clean-up procedures:** Absorb into dry earth or sand. Transfer to a closable, labeled salvage container for disposal by an appropriate method. Wash the spillage site with large amounts of water. Do not use equipment in clean-up procedure which may produce sparks.

#### 7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

**Handling requirements:** Ensure there is sufficient ventilation of the area. Avoid direct contact with the substance. Smoking is forbidden. Use non-sparking tools.

**Storage conditions:** Store in cool, well ventilated area. Keep away from sources of ignition. Keep container tightly closed.
